The decision of the Association recommending acceptance or rejection (including reasons) of the application, shall be advised in writing following the meeting or such appropriate method of communication.

All reasons for rejection or challenge either individually or collectively shall be submitted for full evaluation.

What does it cost to become a Corporate Associated Member?
